



GREEN-AND-WHITE DELIGHT

TOP YOUR TABLE WITH FRESH-FROM-THE-garden greens and classic white blooms for an extra helping of happy.

SIPS OF SERENITY: For an up-to-the-minute centerpiece that practically arranges itself, start with the classic beauty of a white rose, then add clean, crisp greenery. "Leaves recently have been rediscovered as a bold, graphic way to add interesting shape, line and texture to bouquets," observes Casey Cooper, floral designer and owner of Botanicals in Chicago. So snip a few leaves from your houseplants to line a trio of martini glasses, and top each with a rose. To treat guests to their own personal oasis, tuck a rose and ferns into a napkin ring hot-glued with mini rubber-plant leaves. ■
