Instead of walls, Doblin has room dividers, which he constantly readjusts to fit his needs. For the moment, a wooden arch from the Golden Triangle, originally a gate to an early 20th-century Chinese garden, stands just beyond the front door, serving as an entryway to the "dining room." It's an ideal focal point for Doblin's glass house, whose windows look out onto courtyards on both sides, and which is fully encapsulated by a metal sheath. 🍃
